
# **The State of Trans\* and Intersex Organizing Globally**



### THIS YEAR'S BUDGET



Trans\*/intersex groups that are located in high income countries don't necessarily have access to more resources than trans\*/intersex groups in low income countries. Trans\* and intersex-led groups have significantly less access to funding than those that are not self-led.


